Guidelines for CEESA Activities During Flu Season

Guidelines:

- 1. If there is a State Department travel alert, the event is off (This is a long standing CEESA rule).
- 2. If school is open, the event is on.
- 3. School healthcare professionals need to check all the students and chaperones from school and send a "health certificate" with the chaperones.
- 4. If school is closed, the affected school may decide to send students and chaperones with the required health check. Host schools have the right to cancel an invitation if they feel it necessary to safeguard the health of their students.
- 5. In the event an event is canceled, extraordinary costs incurred are borne by the schools affected; site costs by the host, other costs by the participating schools.
- 6. Articles on the latest health information should be shared among schools and made available to the parent community.
